- The Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") vide its General circular No. 09/2023 dated 25 September 2023 in relation to "Clarification on holding of Annual General Meeting (AGM) and EGM through video conferencing (VC) or other audio-visual means (OAVM) and passing of Ordinary and Special resolutions by the companies under the Companies Act, 2013" (the "MCA Circular") has allowed the Companies to conduct their AGM and EGM through VC or OAVM up to 30 September 2024. In line with the MCA Circular, the Securities and Exchange Board of India vide its circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFDPoD- 2/P/CIR/2023/167 in relation to "Relaxation from compliance with certain provisions of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015" (the "SEBI Circular") has relaxed the applicability of regulation 36(1)(b) of the (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) (LODR) Regulations, 2015 for Annual General Meetings (AGMs) and regulation 44(4) of the LODR Regulations for general meetings (in electronic mode) till 30 September 2024. In compliance with the MCA Circular, SEBI Circular and the erstwhile MCA and SEBI circulars issued in this behalf, the AGM of the members of the Company is being held through VC / OAVM. The registered office of the Company shall be deemed to be the venue for the AGM.
- 2. A MEMBER ENTITLED TO ATTEND AND VOTE AT THE AGM IS ENTITLED TO APPOINT A PROXY TO ATTEND AND VOTE ON HIS / HER BEHALF AND THE PROXY NEED NOT BE A MEMBER OF THE COMPANY. - 5. The place of the AGM for the statutory purposes shall be the registered office of the Company.
- 6. In compliance with the MCA Circulars and SEBI Circular dated October 07, 2023, Annual Report 2023-24 including Notice of AGM is being sent only through electronic mode to those members whose email addresses are registered with the Company/ Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (RTA) / Depository Participants as on Monday, 2nd September, 2024. - 7. Remote e-Voting: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 (as amended), the Company is providing facility of remote e-voting to its Members through e-Voting agency with M/s. Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL). Only those Members, whose names appear in Register of Members / List of beneficial owners as on Monday, September 23, 2024 ("Cut-off Date") shall be entitled to vote (through remote e-voting and during AGM) on the resolutions set forth in this Notice and their voting rights shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the Cut-off Date. A person who is not a member as on the Cut-off Date should treat this Notice for information only.

- 19. The Board of Directors has appointed A.J. Sarma & Associates, Company Secretaries, as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the remote e-voting and e-voting during the AGM in a fair and transparent manner
- 20. The Scrutinizer will make a consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the total votes cast in favour or against and invalid votes, if any, to the Chairman / Managing Director of the Company or in his absence to any other Director authorized by the Board of Directors, who shall countersign the same. Based on the Scrutinizer's Report, the result will be declared by the Chairman / Whole-Time Director or in his absence by the Company Secretary within two working days from the conclusion of the AGM at the Registered Office of the Company. Subject to receipt of requisite number of votes, the resolutions shall be deemed to be passed on the date of the AGM i.e., September, 30 2024.
- 21. PROCEDURE FOR REMOTE E-VOTING AND E VOTING DURING THE AGM PROCEDURE FOR REMOTE E- VOTING THE INSTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR E-VOTING AND JOININGVIRTUAL MEETINGS ARE AS UNDER:
 - The remote e-voting period begins on 27th September, 2024 at 9:00 am and ends 29th September, 2024 at 5:00 pm. During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of 23rd September, 2024 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
 - (i) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.
 - (ii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/ retail shareholders is at a negligible level.
 - Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.
 - In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.
 - (iii) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. ITEN NO.3: RATIFICATION OF APPOINTMENT OF COST AUDITORS:
